


Native American Jewelry

Native Americans used shells, seeds, bones, teeth, stones, copper, and feathers to make body decorations, including jewelry such as bracelets and necklaces.

After glass beads were introduced by Europeans, Native Americans became experts in designing colorful belts, headbands, and jewelry. They used designs from their culture as well as using new patterns from European designs.
