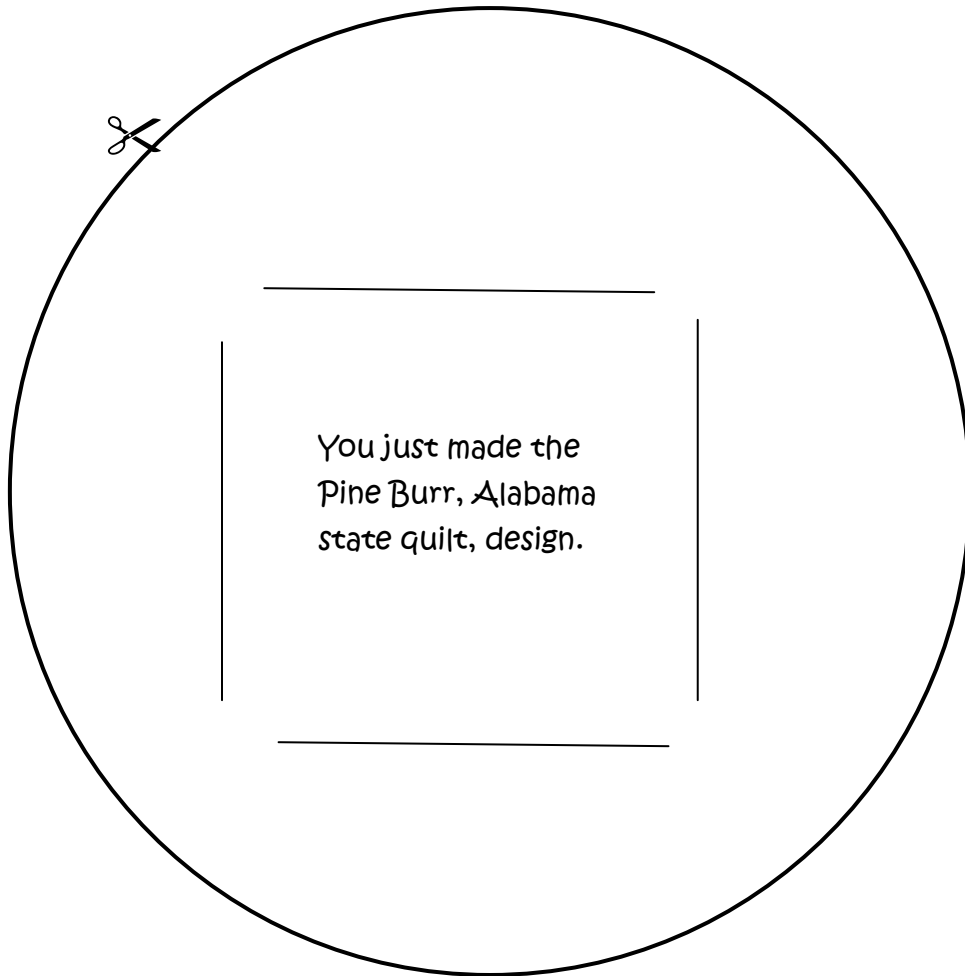


Make your own piece of the Alabama Pine Burr State Quilt

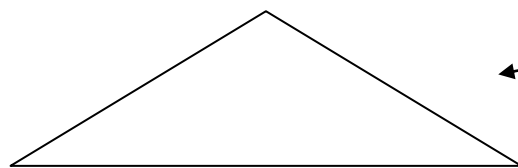


Instructions:

1. Cut out the circle.
2. Start your Pine Burr design by placing and gluing the bottom of the triangles on the straight lines. The top points should be facing in towards the middle.
3. Glue the next row of triangles: place the top triangle points of second row about a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch back from the top triangle points of the first row. The bottom points of the triangles should touch each other. Glue enough triangles to complete the circle. Hint: The spaces between the glued triangles should form a star-like pattern.
4. Glue the third row of triangles in the same way as the second row. The bottom points of your triangle will hang off the edge of the circle.

Hint: Each row will require more triangles to complete the circle.

5. Trim around the paper circle to cut off any triangle points that hang over the edge.



Use this triangle as a template to cut out fabric triangles.
