


Build a House

Design this house using features listed on the Architectural Features information sheet.

Cut and fold the house together:

1. Cut on all solid lines.
2. Fold on all dotted lines.
3. Tuck in the bottom flaps starting with A and finishing with C.
4. Fold the house together. Tuck the roof inside to fit along the interior wall.
5. Glue the side flap inside the interior wall of the opposite house side.



ARCHITECTURAL FEATURES = DIFFERENT PARTS OF A HOUSE

COLUMN: A post that can support the roof or for decoration.





DOUBLE HUNG




FAN LIGHT



SIDE LIGHT


ARCH: The curved top of an opening, like a door or window that acts as a support.



SEGMENTED ARCH




TUDOR ARCH




ROUND ARCH


SHINGLE: A piece of material, like wood or slate, that covers roofs and sides of a house. Shingles can be arranged in many patterns.






