

Día de los Muertos – Day of the Dead – Mask

Color the skull. To make it a mask, cut the skull and the eyes out. Glue a wooden stick (this will be your mask handle) on the back of the mask. Wait until the glue dries and hold the mask in front of your face.

The Hispanic holiday of Día de los Muertos, or Day of the Dead, takes place during the first two days of November.

It is said that during Día de los Muertos, it is said that the spirits of the dead come back to visit the living.

While the holiday's observations include spending time in a cemetery, making shrines to the dead, and displaying skeletons and skulls, the occasion is joyful, instead of sad or scary.
