



Alabama Academy of Honor Accepting Nominations until April 12, 2013

Montgomery, AL – The Alabama Academy of Honor is inviting nominations for its Class of 2013. “We welcome nominations for this great honor,” said Dr. Catherine J. Randall, the Academy’s chairman. Randall noted that membership in the Academy is limited to 100, excluding governors who are automatically members by virtue of office. Current members will elect new members to be inducted at a ceremony at the State Capitol in the fall.

The State Legislature created the Alabama Academy of Honor on October 29, 1965, to bestow honor and recognition upon living Alabamians for outstanding accomplishments and service that have greatly benefitted or reflected great credit on the State. Among the Academy’s current members are Hank Aaron, Harper Lee, Condoleezza Rice, and E. O. Wilson.
