2016 STUDENT RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS

The Friends of the Alabama Archives is sponsoring two \$1,000 Student Research Fellowships in 2016. The fellowships are available to senior-level or graduate students in an Alabama college or university or to Alabama residents in study at a school outside the state. They are intended to help offset expenses incurred while conducting research using the collections of the Alabama Department of Archives and History. A committee of the Friends Board of Directors will review the applications and make awards based on its evaluation of project significance and work plan feasibility.

Applications should include the following:

- Name

- Previous degree if graduate student
- Description of research project
- Plan of work
- Letter of reference from major professor or department head (may be sent separately)

Applicants are welcome to submit an additional letter of reference, a résumé, a brief writing sample, or similar materials.
