I regret very much to have to ask you for further information but failed to tell me the place and date and circumstances of your son's death and where he is buried. I note that you say his last address was Bethlehem, Pa., and follow this with the date May 29, 1918, which I suppose is the date of his death but I would like the other question answered. Was your son connected with the 28th Infantry, Co. K., at the time of his death. From what you may tell me I will get what I need to use in the book. I am very anxious to give these dear boys as much credit and as full a record as possible.
