

ALABAMA IN EUROPEAN WAR.

NAME: mMcCall, C. M.

P.O: Brewton, Escambia Co.

SERVICE RECORD: Class of 1916, Alabama Polytechnic Institute, Auburn. First Lieutenant, First Infantry, Alabama National Guard. Severely gassed and died from pneumonia.

Killed in action by machine gun fire. He conducted his platoon across river, upon being withdrawn his body was brought back and buried in the village of Villette, August 9, 1918. Auburn Alumnus, February 15, 1919, p.101.
