Montgomery, AL 11/24/14 – The Alabama Department of Archives and History (ADAH), in partnership with Alabama Public Television (APT), will host ***Abbey at the Archives*** on Thursday, December 11, 2014. Two preview screenings of the first hour of the new, season five premiere of ***Downton Abbey*** will be shown **at 4 pm and 6 pm**. A special presentation of 1920s fashions from the Archives collection will precede each screening at 3:45 pm and 5:45 pm respectively. Period attire is encouraged. Refreshments will be served.

The event is **free** to the public, but a ticket will be necessary to attend the event as seating is very limited. Tickets for each showing will be available for **pick-up only** at the ADAH beginning **Monday, December 1**. They can be picked up in the ADAH's Museum Store from 8:30 to 4:00, Monday through Saturday. Tickets are limited to 4 per person.
