From **9 am until noon on Saturday, October 18**, the Alabama Department of Archives and History (ADAH) will offer “Untangling the Web: Finding Your Alabama Ancestors in Cyberspace.” Join ADAH expert genealogist, Nancy Dupree, as she leads half-day workshop specifically focusing on how to utilize the numerous online resources available for family history research. This course will offer step-by-step instruction and opportunities to learn about the many research tools available in the ADAH’s EBSCO Research Room.

Through this course, participants will gain valuable knowledge of the best websites, online resources and most effective genealogical search strategies to take their family history research to the next level. Dupree will devote time to providing instruction about how to use online resources including Ancestry.com and Fold3. This workshop is suited for all levels of research experience.
