Montgomery, AL (3/2/15) – The Museum of Alabama, located at the Alabama Department of Archives and History (ADAH), will be open to the public on Sunday afternoons for the month March in addition to its regular hours of operation.

The museum will be open from **1:00 to 4:30 pm** Sunday, **March 8**; Sunday, **March 15**; Sunday, **March 22**; and Sunday, **March 29**. ADAH staff hopes that these extended hours will make visiting the museum more convenient for local residents and the many out-of-town visitors expected in the area during the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Selma-to-Montgomery March commemorations.

Admission to the Museum of Alabama and the ADAH is always **FREE**. Regular hours of operation are Monday through Saturday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.
