Montgomery, AL (10/7/15) – On Saturday, October 10, 2015, the Alabama Department of Archives and History will present *Caring for Your Digital Archives* from 10:00 to 11:00 am in the Joseph M. Farley Alabama Power Auditorium. This presentation, led by Assistant Director for Government Services Tracey Berezansky, will provide instruction for organizing and protecting personal electronic records like digital photographs, emails, and other documents. Admission is free.

October 10 is Electronic Records Day, part of Archives Month celebrations around the world that highlight the important work that archives and archivists do to collect and share the past. In today's digital world, records are created electronically at a rapid pace. Digital images and other electronic documents fill hard drives, creating confusion, frustration, and concern about their stability and protection. Berezansky will provide valuable tips and guidance for organizing personal archives and protecting them for future generations.
