### Fall Season: August-December 2012

#### The First Alabamians

Grades: 3-5

Group size: 2 classes (no more than 60)

Children will learn about the lifestyles, cultures, and behaviors of Alabama Indians through a hands-on session and a guided examination of the *First Alabamians Gallery*. Students will also gain an appreciation for artifacts.

Addresses *Alabama Course of Study: Social Studies Standards, 2004 4<sup>th</sup>: #2, #3 and 5<sup>th</sup>: #4*

#### Then and Now: Famous Faces

Grades: 1-2

Group size: 2 classes (no more than 60)

Children will learn about the objects and people of Alabama's past through two hands-on activities, and exploration of the *Sampler Gallery*.

Addresses *Alabama Course of Study: Social Studies Standards, 2004 1<sup>st</sup>:#1 and 2<sup>nd</sup>: #1, #2*



#### Touch of History

Grades: 3-12

Group size: 2 classes (no more than 70)

Students will learn the cultural, economic, and social aspects of Alabama Indians, lifestyles of 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> centuries, and Alabama's military history. Students will also gain an appreciation for artifacts and archival documents.

Addresses *Alabama Course of Study: Social Studies Standards, 2004 4<sup>th</sup>: #2, #3, #6, #7, #10, #11, #12, #14; and 5<sup>th</sup>: #4, #12; and 6<sup>th</sup>: #6, #10, #13*

#### Hands - on Time

Grades: pre-K-1<sup>st</sup>

Group size: 1 class (no more than 30)

Children will discover Alabama history and compare today's modern living with the past by hands-on exploration with artifacts, props, and history related activities in the *Hands-on Gallery*.

Addresses *Alabama Course of Study: Social Studies Standards, 2004 K: #2 and 1<sup>st</sup>:#1, #2*

#### How to Research

Grades: 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>

Group size: 1 class

In a classroom setting, students will learn about how to research using primary and secondary sources and archival materials.

### Spring Season: January-May 2013

**The Sampler Gallery will close on January 1, 2013, and other unexpected closings may be necessary during construction.**

#### Touch of History (available galleries)

Grades: 3-12

Group size: Limit: **No more than 55. This number includes students, teachers and ALL chaperones**

Students will learn about two exhibit galleries, including the *First Alabamians*.

- All tours are guided tours, led by a docent. To ensure safety during construction, self-guided tours will not be available.
- Tours are scheduled on the hour, Monday – Friday, 9:00 – 3:00. All tours last approx. 50 mins.

- Reservations are held for 15 minutes. **Tours will be cancelled if you are more than 15 minutes late for your appointment.**
